For easy integration, the 12320 features a fast 320MB/s dual port SCSI interface, and maximizes performance with up to 1GB of cache memory.

Importantly, the product has dual-host capability and optional dynamic volume sharing. Dynamic Network Factory's Dynamic Share software allows multiple users to work simultaneously on a single NTFS volume, thus increasing productivity and avoiding the downtime associated with leaving a single computer in control.

Continuity is ensured by dual power supplies, hot-swappable drives, and highly sensitive environment monitoring. In case of any anomalies, this unit can send alerts via fax or email. The data protection subsystem offers a wide range of RAID levels, including 0, 1, 0+1, 3, 5, 30, 50 and JBOD, allowing administrators to choose a suitable level of performance and safety. All RAID functionality is transparent and independent of operating systems. The Enterprise 12320 is designed for applications requiring high data throughput, superior availability, and flexibility of configuration.
